Beginning of renovation works of the historic Castle in Olecko

On 26th March 2020, Olecko District signed two contracts for the renovation of the historic building "Castle" in Olecko. The investment with a total value of PLN 1,077,433.24 is implemented as part of the project "15 seconds of history through the eyes of young people. Castles, barracks and legends" within the Poland-Russia Cross-border Cooperation Programme 2014-2020.

The window and door carpentry will be renovated by NATURAL OKNA Sp. z o.o. from Olsztyn. The scope of work includes the dismantling of old windows and internal window sills, delivery and installation of new windows and wooden window sills, as well as renovation of the external door and two pairs of the tower's vestibule interior door.

The company ZAKŁAD OGÓLNOBUDOWLANY Spółka z o. O. From Warsaw will carry out external renovation of the building. The scope of work includes: replacement of damaged flashings and guttering, renovation of the brick surface of the walls along with the replacement of glazed fittings, and renovation of window grilles.

Window replacement and door repairs are expected to be completed in 2020, while renovation work on the facade of the building is expected to be completed in mid-2021.
