Working visit in Oziersk

Thanks to the great involvement of teachers of the Technical School Complex in Olecko, and in particular Dr Marek Górński, on 1st November 2019, the project "15 seconds of history through the eyes of young people. Castles, barracks and legends", financed from the Poland-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Program 2014-2020, began in the Castle in Olecko.

The project is coordinated by the Olecko District and the College of Agrotechnologies and Environmental Engineering in Gusev, and mainly by its branch in Oziersk. It is the nature of the investment and its main activity is the renovation of historic buildings that are included in the partner schools: "Castle" in Olecko and parts of the former barracks in Oziersk, which in the future are to be a tourist attraction in these areas. In addition to the investment, the project involves a number of activities that will involve young people and teachers from both schools, as well as non-governmental organizations cooperating with them, especially the Active People Association of "Castle".

On 26th-27th November in Gusev, the first meeting of the project management team was held, at which financial and organizational issues of the project were discussed, as well as the schedule of subsequent visits. The delegation from Olecko visited both the historic partner cities of Gusev and Oziersk, got acquainted with the workshop facilities, facilities that will be renovated as part of the project, and the entire Ozierski complex of former barracks, where the College branch is currently located. The next visit will take place in Olecko at the end of April 2020.

The meeting was rich in new ideas and gave motivation to implement the intended activities.
